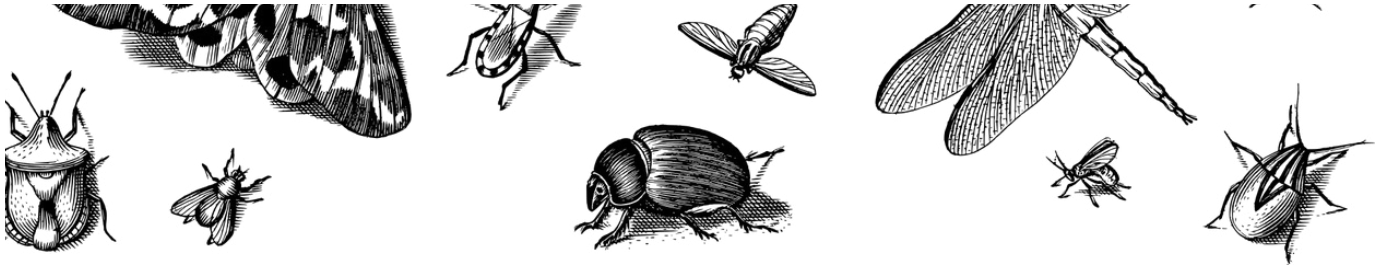


Hangaia he hōtēra ngāngara Construct a bug hotel

Ngā taputapu

Kotahi te pātara kirihou (e rua rita te rahi)
He rākau iti, he huapaina, he kiri rākau
He aho

He whāinga

He ngohe tēnei mō te whānau mō te tamaiti rānei
Hangaia he whare mahana, he hōtēra rānei mō ngā ngāngara.

Ngā tohutohu

Tapahia te pātara kirihou kia rua ngā puoto.

Whakakī katoa ngā puoto ki ngā rākau iti, ngā hua paina, ngā kiri rākau me ētahi atu rawa māori.
Whakakīa ngā puoto kia kī tonu, kia noho kiato.

Kātahi, hereherea ngā puoto e rua mā te aho, ā, whakairia tō hōtēra ngāngara ki tētahi kaupeka rākau ki te tāepa rānei.



Instructions

Cut a two-litre plastic bottle into two cylinders, then stuff it with sticks, pine cones, bark, or any other natural material. Make sure to pack the organic material tightly. Then loop a piece of twine or yarn around the two cylinders and hang your bug hotel from a tree branch or fence.
