Ngā taputapu:

He pepa tapawhā rite, ngā penehinu/pene whītau rānei, he pene.

Equipment:

A square piece of paper, crayons or felt pens, a pen.

Kōrero ki ōu hoa, ki tō whānau, ki tāu mōkai pea.

Talk to your friends, your family or your pets.

Kia ora! | Hello

Ko wai tōu ingoa? | What is your name?

“Kōwhiria tētahi tae”. | Choose a colour.

- Whakamahia te pepa kohe hei tātaki (spell) tae (k, ō, wh, a, i)

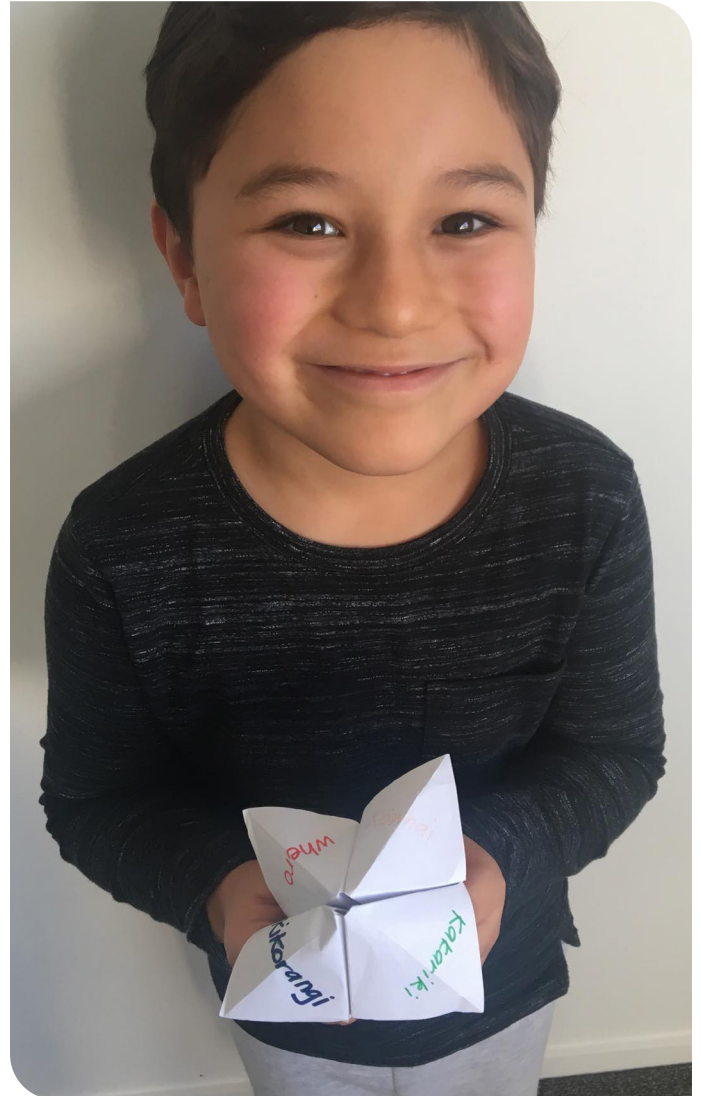
“Kōwhiria tētahi nama”. | Choose a number.

- Whakamahia te pepa kohe kia tatau (tahi, rua, toru...)

“Kōwhiria tētahi nama anō”. | Choose another number.

- Whakamahia te pepa kohe kia tatau anō (tahi, rua...)

- Tirohia ngā kōrero e huna ana kei raro i te nama



Ngā rerenga kōrero, hei tauira.

Some sentences to include, as examples.

Mīharo koe – You're awesome

Tau kē koe – You're neat alright

Te mutunga mai o te pai – You're ultimately awesome

Kei runga noa atu koe – You're up there

Tō kerewa hoki – You are so clever

To māia hoki – You are so brave

To ataahua hoki – You are so beautiful

He tino pai koe ki te kanikani – You are a very good dancer

He tino pai koe ki te waiata – You are a very good singer
